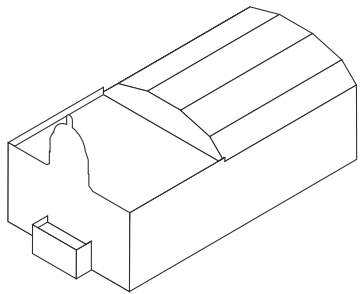
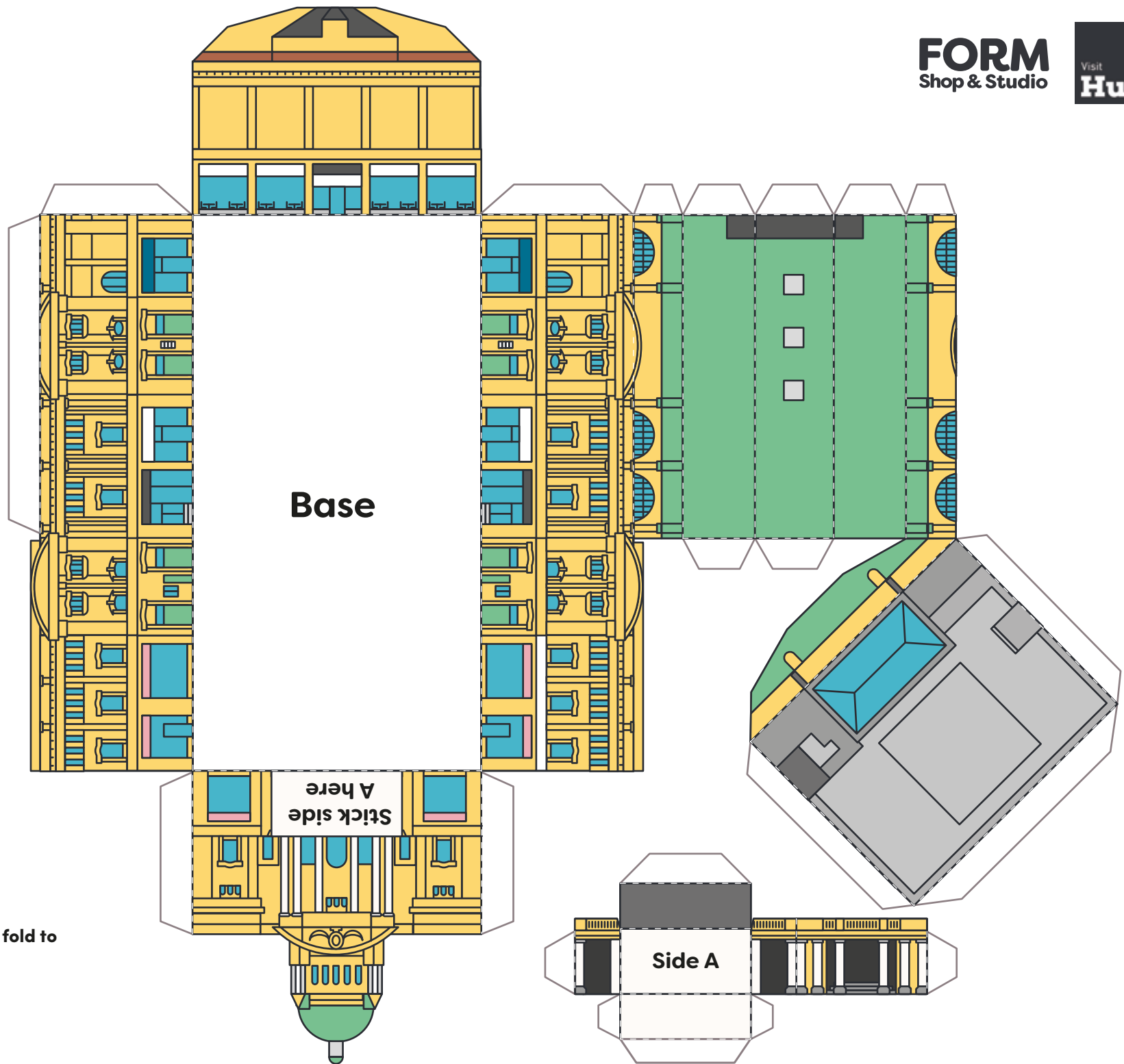


Hull City Hall

The grade II listed Hull City Hall was designed by Hull's City architect Joseph Hirst in the Baroque Revival style, was built between 1903 and 1909. The Victoria Art Gallery, then the city's art gallery, opened in the hall in 1910 until 1927 when it was moved to a neighbouring new building, now the Ferens Art Gallery.

Hull City Hall features one the countries largest working organs in use in the country. Built by Forster and Andrews of Hull and installed in 1911.
