Gaul - 50th Anniversary - Memorial Events 8 - 11 February 2024

On February 8 1974 the Trawler Gaul was declared "lost" with all 36 crew lost in the Barents sea off Norway, having set sail from Hull on January 22nd. This was described as the greatest ever single-trawler tragedy. 30 of the men were from Hull, six from Shields. all are listed below.
