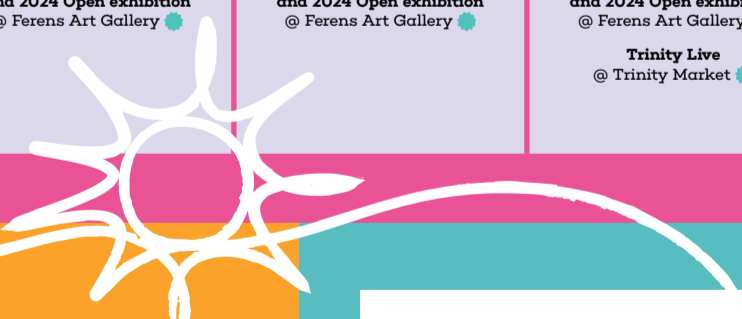

Enjoy the summer vibes in the **Queen Victoria Square Fountains**. Watch the dancing water or cool off in the streams.

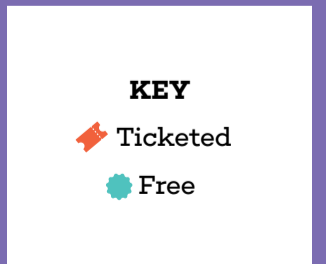
Or when it pours...

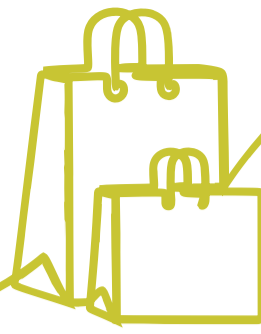

For free days out that kids actually want to go on, take your pick from a host of galleries and museums to the fin-tastic **Fish Trail**. Even better we'll let you into a little secret, a lot of it's completely free!

Take a trip to the **Museums Quarter** in High Street where you can take a spin through the ages or marvel at the giant mammoth. After a year of renovation, the historic **Wilberforce House**, birthplace of slavery abolitionist, William Wilberforce is also back open to the public.

As well as having one of the finest regional art collections in the country, **Ferens Art Gallery** also has an interactive children's gallery and have a delicious, new summer menu in the gallery cafe. While **Humber Street Gallery** is home to a range of temporary visual arts exhibitions and events.

Step back in time at **Dinostar**, Hull's very own interactive dinosaur museum to see, touch, hear and smell these mighty prehistoric creatures. Dive into the amazing world of marine life at **The Deep**, one of the most spectacular aquariums in the UK. Meet mesmerizing sea creatures, and come face to face with Gentoo Penguins. Explore the underwater tunnel and ride the glass lift through the Endless Ocean tank.

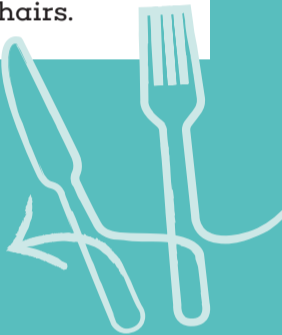

The serene, waterfront **Fruit Market** houses many family friendly spots. **Bert's** provides room for the whole family with ample space and a menu full of woodfired pizzas and gelato to match. Further down **Humber Street**, **Nibble** provides breakfast, brunch and lunch with a vast children's menu and space to dine in and outside.

Across Murdoch's Connection, head to **Princes Dock Street** for more al fresco dining or family classics in **Princes Quay Shopping Centre**. If you have lots of little critics to please, **Trinity Market** matches everyone's palates with world cuisine from Greece, India, China, Italy, freshly roasted coffee to keep the grown-ups going and a relaxed communal seating area featuring plenty of high chairs.

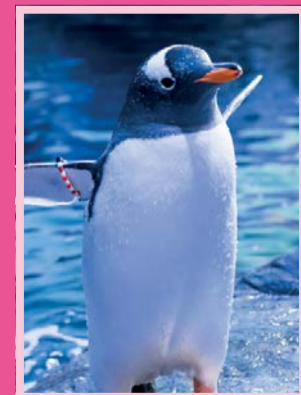
