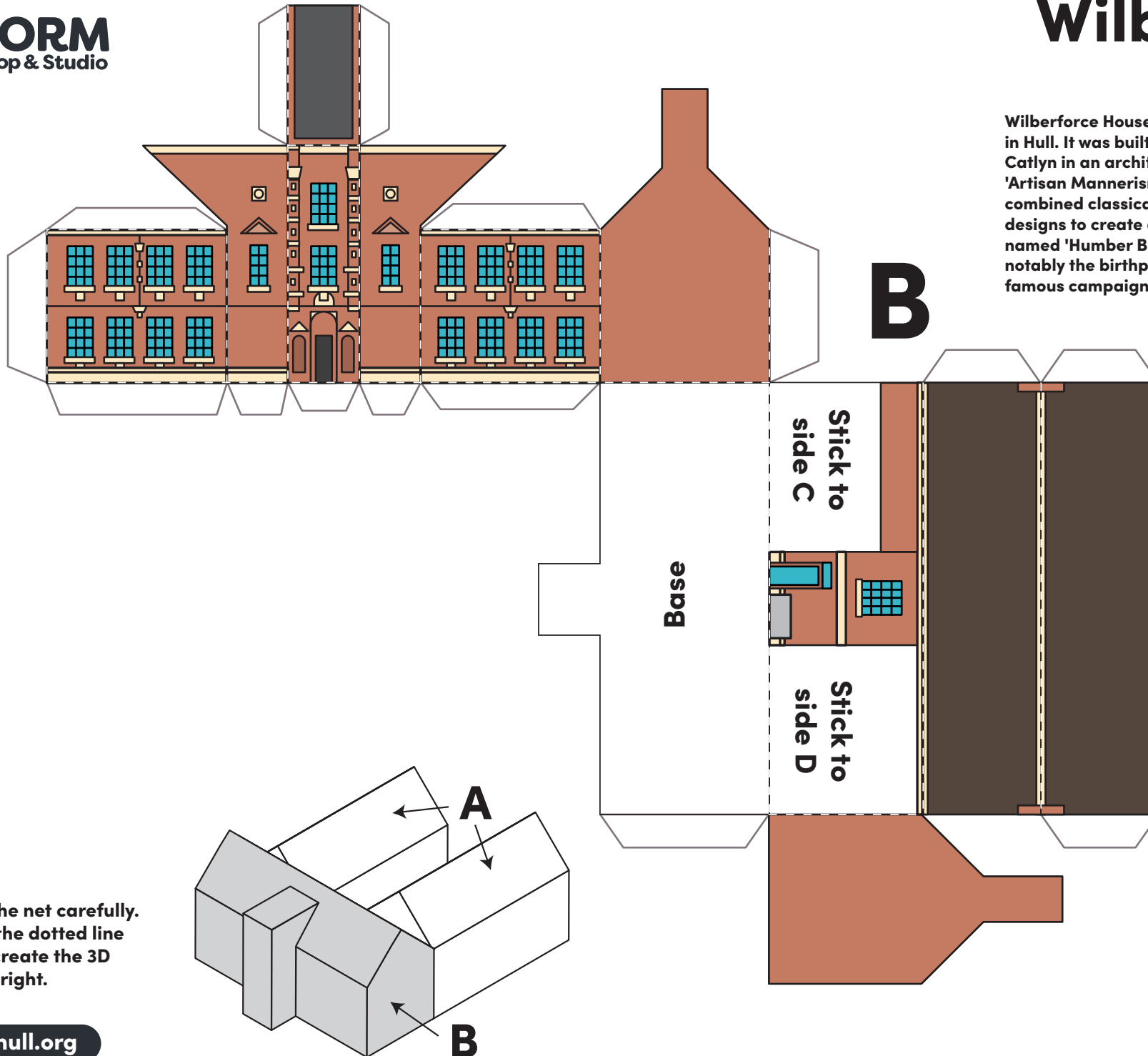


Wilberforce House

Wilberforce House is one of the oldest buildings in Hull. It was built around 1660 by William Catlyn in an architectural style known as 'Artisan Mannerism'. This unusual design combined classical influences with local designs to create an original style, otherwise named 'Humber Brick'. Wilberforce House is notably the birthplace of William Wilberforce, famous campaigner against the slave trade.
